The summer of rosé is in full swing! It's an international love affair, with rosé wine being made around the world from a variety of different grapes. Try one of these AG picks tonight:



## **Bridge Lane Rosé 2013** North Fork of Long Island, New York

This wine comes from <u>Lieb Cellars</u>, founded in 1992 on Long Island's North Fork. Lieb was the first winery on Long Island to plant Pinot Blanc, which has become their signature wine and makes up part of the blend in the Bridge Lane rosé.

The 2013 wine is 63% Cabernet Franc, 21% Merlot, 8% Pinot Blanc, 5% Riesling and 3% Gewurztraminer. Light and easy to drink with a pretty pale pink color, the wine has flavors of wild strawberry, raspberry and rose petal.
